There are some changes to make and some paperwork to clean up. They will provide the list of findings to address. Changes have been made to process for enrolling new children who qualify using the correct forms.  Molly finished her business associates class.  The licensing capacity at BCS is back to 60 children.  The contract with Head Start is not finalized. There are children to fill the HS as well as Early HS slots.  BCS received a special accommodation grant and Rowan will serve as a 1 on 1 until August.  The Strengthening Families request went back in last week. They are funding the rest of 2023 and 3 quarters in 2024. The amount is 100,000 for 5 quarters of the year.  The community garden grant is 5,000 and being put to good use.  Mascoma may still fund the party but it is known how much and when.  Tuition  We do not want to change the sliding scale at this time for paying families. Some current families are not currently at the sliding scale level for their income. When we set this scale, some of the increased were more than 10% for some families so we only moved them 10% last year.

Financials	<ul> <li>Alan has provided another FY23 budget revision based on some more known income for this year.</li> <li>This budget predicts we will have a 50,000 deficit at the end of the year that will be filled with money from the endowment. This is an improvement from the earlier budget that was</li> </ul>		

	predicting a 175,000 deficit.  This Budget Revision was voted on and approved.
